

Instructions for correctly applying Blackbird Racing seat covers:

Initial notes:

Blackbird Racing uses high-quality materials, tested by the world's top teams. Nevertheless, there are a few simple rules that should be followed:

- always make sure your hands are clean.
- apply the covers at a temperature of between 15 and 25°C.
- make sure the sponge and the surface of the seat are perfectly clean before application.
- check the condition of the existing sponge very carefully, repairing any small cuts if required, using glue and a rasp to shape it.

How to Apply:

- 1 Remove the previous cover, using a small screwdriver to remove all the staples.
- 2 Position the new seat and fix it with metal stitches, first at the front and then at the rear, making sure it is perfectly centered.
- 3 Smooth the cover down, alternating the right and left sides to ensure it adheres perfectly to the sponge and is not asymmetrical to it.
- 4 Heat the edges of the new cover using a hairdryer and complete the application, making sure there are no folds or wrinkles on the seat.
- 5 Use a utility knife or scissors to trim excess material below the seat.
